

WIN A CAPE YORK ADVENTURE WITH 4X4 AUSTRALIA

Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter and the prizes forms part of the Terms and Conditions. Entry into the promotion is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
2. Entry is only open to residents of Australia aged 18 years or over who are available to travel to Cape York, QLD Australia from 08/08/2019 to 21/08/2019 in the event they are drawn as the winner.
3. Employees of the Promoter and their immediate families and associated agencies with this promotion are not eligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1st cousin.
4. The promotion commences on 07/03/2019 and concludes on 29/05/2019 at 23.59pm (AEST) ("**Promotional Period**").

6. Each entrant may complete each entry mechanic once, for a maximum of one hundred and one (101) entries. The use of any automated entry software or any other mechanical or electronic means that allows an entrant to automatically enter repeatedly is prohibited and will render all entries submitted by that entrant invalid.
